Annual Employment Review March-2007

CHAPTER - I

I. HIGH LIGHTS :-

1.1 Total Employment :-

Total employment in the organised sector of economy in Gujarat State **increased** from **17.55 lacs** at the end of **March-2006** to **18.04 lacs** at the end of **March-2007** recording a **rise of 0.49 lacs**.

1.2 Employment in Public Sector :-

Employment in Public Sector **decreased** from **8.24 lacs** at the end of **March 2006** to **7.96 lacs** at the end of **March-2007** recording thereby a **fall 0.28 lacs**.

1.3 Employment in Private Sector :-

Employment in Private Sector **increased** from **9.31 lacs** at the end of **March 2006** to **10.08 lacs** at the end of **March-2007** recording a **rise of 0.77 lacs**.

1.4 Employment by Industries Division :-

Table No.V shows (Industries division wise) that employment **increased** in Manufacturing (**7.68%**), Wholesale & Retail trade, Hotels & Restaurant (**8.89%**), Financing, Insurance & Real Estate. (**4.17%**) and **decreased** in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing (**3.85%**), Mining & Quarrying (**12.50%**) Construction (**3.70%**), Transport, Storage & Communication (**1.30%**). Community, Social & Personal Services (**0.82%**)

There is **no change** in Electricity, Gas & Water Sector

1.5 Women Employment :-

Total number of women employment was **2.41 lacs** at the end of **March- 2006** to **2.50 lacs** at the end of **March-2007** there by recording a rise in women employment by **0.09 lacs**.

1.6 Area wise Employment :-

Area wise analysis of employment is given in Appendix-II, Employment raised mainly in **Ahmedabad** (+17124), **Kutch** (+11020), **Bharuch** (+5363), **Panchmahal** (+1875), **Dahod** (+1033), **Anand** (+2279), **Banaskantha** (+4952), **Surat** (+14191) and **Valsad** (+3002) Districts.

Decrease in Employment was in **Amreli** (-1212) **Bhavnagar** (-2252), **Narmada** (-1606), **Gandhinagar** (-3115), **Junagadh** (-1525), **Porbandar** (-1170), **Rajkot** (-1034) and **Vadodara** (-4139) Districts.

1.7 Job Seekers :-

The number of work seekers on the Live Register of Employment Exchanges in Gujarat State was **8.31 lacs** at the end of **March-2006** which was **reduced to 7.79 lacs** at the end of **March 2007**. The number of educated job seekers was **7.25 lacs** at the end of **March 2006** which was **reduced to 6.90 lacs** at the end of **March-2007**, thereby recording a **decrease of 0.35 lacs** or **4.82 %** and the number of uneducated work seekers **decreased** from **1.06 lacs**, at the end of **March-2006** to **0.89 lacs** at the end of **March-2007**, thereby recording a **decrease of 0.17 lacs** or **16.03 %**.

1.8 Vacancies Notified :-

The number of vacancies notified to the employment exchanges in Gujarat State was **1.54 lacs** at the end of **March 2006** and **1.93 lacs** at the end of **March-2007**. It shows an **increase of 0.39 lacs** or **25.32 %**

1.9 Placement :-

The number of applicants placed in gainful employment through employment exchanges was **1.31 lacs** at the end of **March-2006** and **1.42 lacs** at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording an increase of **0.11 lacs** or **8.40 %**.

1.10 Employment Index :-

(i) Employment index combined for **public** and **private sector** (considering employment at the end of March 2003 as base 100%) was **110.61%** at the end of **March-2007**.

(ii) The Employment Index in **public sector** (considering employment at the end of March 2003 as base 100%) **93.57%** at the end of **March-2007**.

(iii) The Employment Index in **private sector** (considering employment at the end of March 2003 as base 100%) **129.17%** was at the end of **March-2007**.

CHAPTER - II

INTRODUCTION

Scope and Coverage :-

2.1 The present Employment Review relates to the quarter ended **March-2007**. The data analysis contained in this review is based on the statistics collected under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme. The data information on the level of employment is however, collected only in respect of the organised sector of economy, which comprises of establishments in the public sector and non-agricultural establishments employing 10 or more persons in the private sector. It is worth noting that where as data from all the establishment in the public sector and non-agricultural establishments in private sector employing 25 or more persons are obtained statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act 1959, the data from non-agricultural establishment engaging **10 to 24 persons in the private sectors are collected on a voluntary basis.**

2.2 Collection of data under the EMI Programme is resorted through an "Establishment Reporting System". All the establishments are required to submit details about the number of persons they are employing, vacancies occurred and the type of persons who are found in short supply at quarterly intervals. The information relates only to "Employers and Employees". The term 'Employers' means owners, proprietors, manager, working partners or directors of the firm/companies. On the other hand "Employees" include all those persons whose wage or salaries are paid from the establishments but does not cover part-time employees and apprentices. The EMI programme precisely does not cover the following sector.

- Self employed or independent workers.
- Agricultural and allied operations in the private sector except plantation establishments which are covered on a voluntary basic.
- House hold establishments & domestic services.
- Non Agricultural establishments in the private sector employing less than 10 workers.
- Employment in Indian missions/embassies abroad, Defence forces and those not covered due to administrative reasons and parliament staff.
- Part time, services, less than three months service.

2.3 The programme has the following limitations :-

- (i) The employers register maintained at employment exchanges may not be comprehensive and up to date as required due to various reasons. The possibilities of omission ,therefore, can not be ruled out.
- (ii) Employment in defaulting establishments is estimated on the basis of information furnished by them in the previous quarter. The estimated figure may not reflect the real picture. The response to enquiry ranged from 35 to 50 percent (see table No.1).

CHAPTER - III

ESTABLISHMENTS

- 3.1 The details regarding the total number of establishments covered under the Employment Market Information programme in Gujarat State, number of establishments responded and furnishing quarterly information and the percentage of response thereof for the quarter ended **March-2007** and corresponding quarter of the previous year i.e. **March-2006** are given in table No.1.

- 3.2 The above table shows the establishment under the Employment Market Information Programme at the end of **March-2006** were **32.52** thousand as against **33.97** thousand covered at the end of **March-2007**.
- 3.3 The break-up of establishments by different branches of the public and private sector for the year ended **March-2006** and **March-2007** alongwith percentage change over the previous year is given in Table-II.

The above table shows the share of public sector in the total establishment was **24.63%** in **March-2006** and **23.48%** at the end of **March-2007**, on the other hand the share of private sector in total establishment was **75.37%** in **March-2006** and **76.52%** in **March-2007**.

CHAPTER - IV

EMPLOYMENT IN ORGANISED SECTOR (PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR)

4.1. Table No.III below gives the break-up of employment in the organised sector by public and private sector alongwith percentage change over the previous year.

It can be observed from the above table that out of total employment of **18.04** lacs in the organised sector, the public sector counted **7.96** lacs and remaining **10.08** lacs were in private sector. In the public sector, employment went down from **8.24** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **7.96** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording a decrease of **0.28** lacs or **3.40%**.

The employment increased from **9.31** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **10.08** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording an increase of **0.77** lacs or **8.27%** in the case of private sector.

The employment in public and private sector branch wise for the year **March 2006** and **March 2007** alongwith the percentage change over the previous year is given in Table No.IV.

Branch wise analysis of Employment is given as under :-

(A) Public Sector :-

(i) Central Government :-

Employment in Central Government establishments **decreased** from **1.10** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **1.07** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby a recording a **fall** of **2.73%** during the previous year.

(ii) State Government :-

Employment in State Government establishment **decreased** from **1.82** lacs at the end of **March-06** to **1.74** lacs at the end of **March-2007** there by a **fall** of **4.40%** during the previous year.

(iii) Quasi Government (Central) :-

Employment in Quasi Government (Central) establishment **decreased** from **1.07** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **1.04** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby a recording a **fall** of **2.80%** during the previous year.

(iv) Quasi Government (State) :-

Employment in Quasi Government (State) establishment **decreased** from **1.34** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **1.25** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording a **fall** of **6.72%** during the previous year.

(v) Local Bodies :-

Employment in local bodies establishments also **decreased** from **2.91** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **2.86** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording a **fall** of **1.72%** during the previous year.

(B) Private Sector :-

(i) Larger Establishment :-

Employment in larger establishments **increased** from **7.38** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **7.97** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **7.99%** during the previous year.

(ii) Smaller Establishment :-

Employment in smaller establishments **increased** from **1.93** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **2.11** lacs at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording **increased** of **9.33%** during the previous year.

CHAPTER - V

INDUSTRY WISE EMPLOYMENT

Industry wise analysis of employment can be seen in Appendix I in respect of Public and Private Sector.

Industry wise (Division wise) analysis can be seen in table No.V.

It can be seen from above table that the pattern of employment has shown down ward trends as compared to the proceeding year.

Public Sector :-

Total employment in public sector establishment **decreased** form **8.24** lacs at the end of **March-2006** and **7.96** lacs at the end of **March-2007**.

Private Sector :-

Total employment in private sector establishments **increased** from **9.31** lacs at the end of **March-2006** to **10.08** lacs at the end of **March-2007**.

CHAPTER - VI

AREAWISE EMPLOYMENT

Area wise Analysis :-

The break up of employment in organised sector by public sector and private sector classified to district alongwith change over the previous year is furnished in Appendix-II. It can be observed from the Appendix II that nearly **8,88,432** employees or **49.25%** were working in four major districts i.e. **Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Surat and Rajkot**. While the rest **9,15,536** or **50.75%** employees were working in other **21 districts** of Gujarat State.

PUBLIC SECTOR :-

It may be seen from the above table that the women employment in the **Central Govt.** increased from **9.07** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **9.27** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **0.20** thousand or **2.21%**.

Women Employment in **State Govt.** decreased from **22.13** thousand at the end of **March-2006** to **21.66** thousand at the end of **March-2007** thereby recording **fall** of **0.47** thousand or **2.12%**.

Women Employment in **Quasi Govt. (Central)** increased from **11.15** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **11.26** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **0.11** thousand or **0.99%**

Women employment in **Quasi Govt. (State)** decreased from **5.90** thousand at the of **March 2006** to **5.58** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **fall** of **0.32** thousand or **5.42%**.

Women employment in **Local Bodies** also **decreased** from **99.23** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **99.02** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **fall** of **0.21** thousand or **0.21%**.

Women employment in Public Sector as a whole **decreased** from **147.48** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **146.79** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **fall** of **0.69** thousand or **0.47%**.

PRIVATE SECTOR :-

Women employment in larger establishments in private sector **increased** from **67.86** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **75.04** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **7.18** thousand or **10.58%..**

Women employment in smaller establishments in private sector **increased** from **26.20** thousand at the end of **March 2006** to **28.43** thousand at the end of **March 2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **8.51** thousand or **8.51%**.

Over all **increase** of women employment in private sector is from **94.06** thousand in **March 2006** to **103.47** thousand in **March-2007**. thereby recording a **rise** of **9.41** thousand or **10.00%**.

Women employment in the organised sector of economy which was **241.54** thousand as on **March 2006** **increased** to **250.26** thousand as on **March 2007** thereby recording a **rise** of **8.72** thousand or **3.61%**.

CHAPTER - VIII

SUMMARY

The Increase/ decrease in overall employment is due to following reasons.

1. Ban on creating new posts as well as filling up of vacant posts as per the Govt's policy in **Public Sector**.
2. Employment in the **Private Sector** has **increased** due to the following reasons.
 1. Industry friendly policy of the **State Govt**.
 2. Establishment of SEZ special packages for areas like Kutch.
 3. Huge investments by NRIs & foreign companies in the state as a result of Vibrant Gujarat Summits & Seminars.
 4. Industrial peace in the state, good infrastructure facilities and availability of Water, Electricity and Skilled/Unskilled manpower.
