RESOLUTION :-

The Hon. Union Finance Minister in his Budget Speech 2004-05 has stressed that skill imparted by Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) must keep pace with the technological demand of the industries and the expanding universe of knowledge to produce world class work force and create a Public-Private Model for implementing this scheme. In this connection 500 ITIs are to be upgraded over the next five years in the country. In the first phase 100 ITIs are to be upgraded in the first year i.e. current year 2005-06.

[2] During the current year, in Gujarat following 8 ITIs have been selected for the Centre of Excellence scheme in the sectors stated as below:-
